<p>Marianna shared the financial report with attendees.</p> <p>There is average of approximately £10k in parent donations per year</p> <p>Summer Fair &amp; Christmas Fair are biggest fundraisers averaging around £1,700 each</p> <p>The Sponsored Event also big fundraiser bringing in £1,600K</p> <p>The largest expense was the Life Bus £1625, This received good feedback and the committee has committed to fund this again</p> <p>There is approximately £3k unspent from the funds raised last year, and there is £7K left in account that can be spent.</p> <p>Some money has been earmarked for projects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Microphone system - £2k</li> <li>- iPad for Kids Club- £500</li> <li>- Soft furnishings for Kids club - £500</li> </ul> <p>£5.5K is also needed for annual expenses including the Life Bus, experience days and trophies.</p>

<p>Mrs Verney Davies thanked the committee for their work.</p> <p>Paula &amp; Mrs Verney Davies have discussed possible uses for the funds raised by PAWs.</p> <p>One option is installing an additional bike shed. However the previous bike shed installation took 3 years of planning. Scooter stands may be a quicker and more affordable option.</p> <p>The playground markings also need to be refreshed and there is a need for new library books.</p>
