









Spring 2: Space-A place far, far away...

Here are the options for your child to choose from for their home learning project.

 <p><u>Plan a tea party on the moon for aliens.</u> You could draw pictures of the food you want at the party or create a menu. Think about what kind of food an alien might like - star biscuits, rocket jelly or moon cheese balls...</p>	<p><u>Design and make a vehicle that you could use to travel into space.</u> What would it look like? You could make a rocket using cardboard tubes, old boxes... whatever you like!</p> 
 <p>Go outside with an adult when it is dark, or look out the window. Talk about what you can see. Can you count the stars? Can you find the moon? Does the sky change from one night to the next? <u>Collage, draw, paint or chalk a picture and describe what you can see</u> – use some amazing adjectives and <u>write a poem</u></p>	 <p><u>Create and teach your family your own alien language</u> - what word could you use for 'hello'? How about 'blooba', 'floppa' or 'cookaboo'? You choose - it's your alien language! Write some labels, speech or a story using your alien language.</p>
<p>You are going on a spaceship and can only take 10 things with you. What will you take? Either write or draw them in a <u>suitcase</u>.</p> 	<p>Write a <u>factfile</u> or <u>non chronological report</u> about space – What was the first creature sent into space? Who was the first astronaut? Who was the first man on the moon? What other interesting facts can you find?</p> 
<p><u>Design an alien</u> (look to the natural world for features) and create an <u>alien mask</u>. Or make a <u>model of a planet</u></p> 	<p><u>Create a timeline</u> to show the history of space travel.</p>
