
## Riddles

A riddle is a type of poetry that describes something without actually naming what it is, leaving the reader to guess.

Create a collage picture of the Arctic or Antarctic. Think of which animals you will include. Use cold colours.



Create a polar animal food chain. Draw and label your food chain. Think about how this food is different to the food that you eat.



Plan the route from your house to the North or South Pole. List or describe the transport that you would take.



Design your own Arctic or Antarctic animal. Explain how they are adapted to living in the cold weather.
