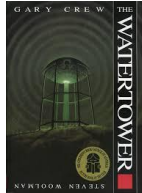


As a writer we will be...

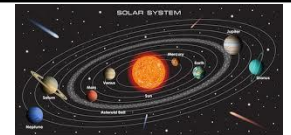
