

Please find below a summary of the points covered in the recent parents' meeting for year 3 children - Introduction and Curriculum.

- The staff in year 3 are Mrs Probert, Miss Parkinson, Mrs Redding and Miss Thomas.
- As from tomorrow, Hazel class will be coming in through the side gate and walking down to the classroom directly. Mrs Probert and Miss Thomas will be near the door to welcome them.
- P.E. days are Tuesdays and Thursdays. Children should avoid wearing any earrings or jewellery on these days. All children should have a full kit in school plus a change of footwear. Please make sure hair is tied back
- The children will be bringing home their reading book. We ask that you record what they have read and sign the book. The book should be returned to school every day even if your child hasn't completed it.
- Helping at home - in year 3 it is very important that you read regularly with your child and help them with learning their times tables
- The children will be bringing home homework menus as in previous years. They will choose from the three options on the menu
- We ask that you support us in encouraging the children to be more independent. They need to start taking responsibility for their own learning and develop their organisational skills
- We are always keen for parents to come in and help. Please speak to either teacher if you would like to. We would like parents to come in daily to hear children read.
- Now that the children are in Key Stage 2 they will be eating in the Key Stage 2 dining hall.
- They are also allowed to buy snacks at break time from the healthy tuck shop.
- If your child has any medication please make sure we have up to date information in school.
- In year 3 the children are not allowed to bring a pencil case to school with coloured pencils etc as they are not needed
- Please make sure your child has their coat and water bottle in school every day (water only please - no juice)
- **Please name all of your child's P.E. kit and uniform. It's much easier to get it back if it is named**
- We are encouraging the children to go to the toilet at break time and lunchtime rather than in lesson time now that they are in year 3
